Freedom of Information Act 2000 request: Temporary Staffing Processes

With reference to your request for information, dated 26<sup>th</sup> January, made under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to inform you of the outcome of your information request.

You asked the following:

1) Do you have a master vendor (MV) arrangement in place for the supply of medical locums? If so please state the name of the provider used (Medacs, Holt, A&E Agency etc.)

The Trust has entered into a strategic partnership with Capita, of which one of the services they supply is the management of our agency staffing providers. This commenced in September 2015.

2) Please state the utilisation rate that has been achieved through the master vendor in the last 12 months. This is the total value of locum spend supplied by the master vendor itself in the last 12 months as a percentage of total locum spend in the same period.

The Capita partnership commenced in September 2015 and, as such, we would not be able to provide data for the previous 12 months, as requested.

3) Does the trust use a direct engagement model to engage locum staff? If so please state the name of the company used (Liaison PwC, 247 Time, Brookson, HB Retinue, Medacs etc.)?

The Trust uses a direct engagement model provided by Liaison PwC to engage with Allied Health Professional locums.

4) Do you run a weekly payroll for medical bank?

The Trust uses Allocate rostering software, which has recently been rolled out and, as such, there are no costs associated with Allocate in 2014/15. The Trust used SMART to roster bank staff the total spend in 2014/15 was £48,160.

The Trust has entered into a strategic partnership with Capita, of which one of the services they supply is the management of our agency staffing providers.

The Trust uses the BankStaff module of Allocate to manage the internal bank staff shift requirements for all categories. This launched in February 2016. Prior to this date, the Trust used the SMART system to release vacancies to bank workers.
