Freedom of Information Act 2000 request: *Hammersmith & Fulham CCG's continence formulary*

With reference to your request for information, dated 28th April 2016, made under section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act, I am writing to inform you of the outcome of your information request.

You asked the following:

1. **'I'm looking to find details of the products/ appliances on Hammersmith & Fulham CCG's continence formulary relating specifically to Sheaths and Leg Bags in use for male urinary incontinence. Can I be informed of where I can access this information?'**

The Camden CCG informed me that the Central London Community Healthcare NHS Trust deals with its continence issues, so I hope I can be directed to the Trust's continence appliance formulary?'

Our response:

There is no Continence formulary. Patients are assessed by Central London Community Healthcare nurses and products are recommended for use. The Manufacturers provide samples to patients and if they are happy with the product, then we inform GPs who take responsibility for the prescribing.
